



Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting

On or after 11 a.m. Monday, Sept. 14, 2020

Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.02, the Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) of the Regional Transportation Authority meetings are open to the public. The RTA is a state-established independent taxing district with jurisdictional authority encompassing all of Pima County. The CAC is the only committee delegated by the RTA Board to develop and recommend a draft 20-year regional transportation plan for approval by the regional governing board and final consideration by voters in the district.

The above referenced meeting was conducted through a webinar format with a YouTube live stream for public access. The public was also invited to submit written comments of any length one hour prior to the start of the meeting for the Citizens Advisory Committee's (CAC) files. However, the topics discussed or submitted by individuals may not be relevant to the CAC's meeting agenda. Therefore, in accordance with Arizona's rules and regulations, CAC members will not discuss or take action on any matter that is not already on the agenda.
